How is it different from other resource lists?

It scores literacy programs on a 12-point scale as either easy, moderate, or complex to implement. Thus, clubs can determine which programs fit their level of resources.

It differentiates between instructional (teaching people to read and write) and augmentative (enhancing skills already

present) programs and those that are involved in delivering books and resources. Thus, clubs can determine which programs fit the needs of the communities they wish to serve.

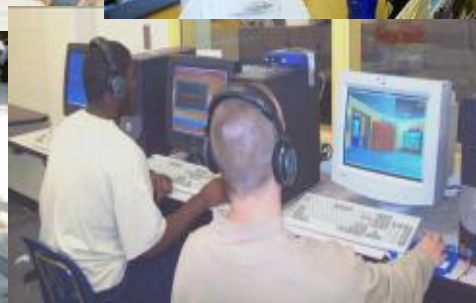
